



RPTO - Registration Requirements for Train the Trainer (TTT) Course - Small Class As per DGCA Guidelines

Eligibility Criteria

"A valid Remote Pilot Certificate (RPC) in the applicable category and class is required at the time of enrollment."

The applicant must possess a Degree from a University/Institute recognized by UGC/AICTE or equivalent, or hold a valid PPL (Private Pilot License), CPL (Commercial Pilot License), AME (Aircraft Maintenance Engineer) License, ATC (Air Traffic Controller) License, or a 3-year Diploma in a technical subject from a recognized institute

Age limit: 18 - 65 years

Proficient in English (Read / Write / Speak)

Should have teaching aptitude and in-depth drone operational knowledge

Identity Proof Guidelines

- Remote Pilot Certificate (RPC) – Valid and issued by a DGCA-authorized RPTO
- Educational Qualification Certificate
 1. Degree or PPL / CPL / AME / ATC License or 3-year Technical Diploma
 2. Final Year Marksheet

Primary ID (Mandatory):

- Aadhaar Card (must be submitted by all candidates)

Secondary ID (Submit any one):

- Passport
- Voter ID (Election Card)
- Driving License



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Medical Certificate

The Medical Certificate format is attached on the last page of this file. Candidates are required to download, print, and get it duly signed, stamped/sealed, and include the registration number of the attending registered MBBS/MD Doctor.

- All documents must be clear, legible, and properly named in soft copy
- Incomplete submissions may delay or disqualify registration
- Minimum 18 years, 65 and Below 65 years
- Mobile number and email ID must be linked with the Aadhaar.
- Candidates will be evaluated based on written tests, simulator performance, and practical flight demonstrations in accordance with DGCA standards.
- During the TTT course, candidates will undergo evaluation through written tests, simulator sessions, and practical flight demonstrations as per DGCA guidelines.

1. The candidate should possess good health and physique with a sound mind. He / she should not be suffering from any disease, physical and mental infirmity.
2. Not suffer from a degree of deafness which would prevent hearing the ordinary sound signals.
3. Able to distinguish with his/her eyesight with or without eyeglasses/contact lenses/laser corrected eyes, at 25 meters in good day, an object of dimensions 30 CM x 30 CM
4. Do not have any defect or deformity or loss of member which would interfere with the efficient performance of his/her duties as a RPA pilot.
5. Able to readily distinguish the VIBGYOR colours and not suffer from Night Blindness.
